I am happy to report that again, The Legacy at North Augusta has no active cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members.

We are completing the state mandated testing needed to move into phase one of reopening. We have not received any positive results during testing. Phase one allows us to start lifting restrictions and offering more group activities. With everything we are doing, residents and team members are still practicing social distancing, wearing masks and disinfecting hands and surfaces regularly.

Our Procurement Director at National Lutheran Communities & Services is working hard to secure items that will help us keep The Legacy free of COVID-19. We are expecting a disinfecting machine in the next 2-3 weeks, which will assist with appropriately disinfecting spaces. We are also looking at UV and air filtration disinfection methods.

We continue to offer Picnic on the Porch visits with residents and family members. This has been a great opportunity for families and residents to engage together.
