The Legacy at North Augusta is in our fourth week with no new cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members!

If we can keep COVID-19 out of the community, on March 1, we will open our dining room for limited, in-person communal dining. Tables will be placed in a way that residents can dine and enjoy each other's company while continuing to practice social distancing. We are also holding in-person small group activities.

We are getting many questions about family visitation. We are working on ways to safely do this, soliciting guidance from the Department of Health and the Centers for Disease Control. When we can have in-person visitation, even though all residents have been vaccinated, visitors will still be required to wear masks and maintain six feet of distance between residents and team members. My number one priority remains keeping residents healthy.

I know this pandemic seems never-ending. I have hope that soon the CDC will release guidance on how to safely move forward with life once everyone has been vaccinated. As we said last week, we encourage family members to receive the vaccine as soon as it is made available to you.
