I am happy to report that The Legacy at North Augusta has had no cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members for the fifth week in a row.

We are planning to resume safe, in-person communal dining next week and can keep this practice in place as long as we can keep COVID-19 out of the community. We also continue small, in-person group activities to keep residents connected and engaged with one another. Everyone remains masked and socially distanced at all times.

I am aware that since all residents and the majority of team members have been vaccinated, we're all ready to move forward and resume "normal" life. We continue to seek guidance from National Lutheran Communities & Services infectious control experts as well as the state and county Department of Health and the CDC. While the vaccine is showing great promise, until a wider portion of the country is vaccinated, we need to remain cautious in moving back to "normal" life. I thank each one of you for your patience as we continue to navigate during this time. We are working on ways to safely allow for indoor community visits and will release more information as soon as it is available.
