Subject: Path Forward Community Update



I am happy to report that again, The Legacy at North Augusta has no active cases of COVID-19 in residents or team members.

We are working on finishing our baseline testing for all team members and residents. So far, there have been no positive test results for COVID. We have moved into phase two of reopening. Phase two allows us to increase small group sizes to ten residents. All residents remain socially distanced and are wearing masks. We also disinfect the activity spaces after each group and are providing hand sanitizer to participants.

As we shared last week, we have been able to secure a Clorox cleaning machine. Our Procurement Director has shared with me that the machines kill 99.9% of bacteria and viruses in five seconds, safely disinfects and sanitizes food service areas, and can be used near any surface, including electronics.

We have also secured COVID-19 rapid test machines. According to the state regulations, we can use these tests when The Legacy is not considered in outbreak status to test team members, new residents and anyone who begins to exhibit symptoms. We expect the rapid test machines to arrive in the next few weeks.

We continue our Picnic on the Porch visits with residents and family members. This has continued to be a great opportunity for families and residents to engage together.
