Last week, we completed all of our baseline testing for COVID-19. None of our team members or residents tested positive for the virus, keeping The Legacy free from COVID-19.

With these results, we are allowed to move into phase three of reopening. Phase three allows us to:

- Have more individuals participate in group activities
- Offer indoor visitation
- Limited Salon services
- Modified Chapel services

Of course, everyone will need to continue to wear facemasks and maintain social distancing. Our highest priority remains keeping everyone healthy and free from COVID-19.

When we start in-person visitation, all visitors will need to be screened for COVID-19, including having their temperature taken. All visits will take place in designated visitation areas, and we ask that visitors not linger in any of the community common spaces.

Specific guidelines and details for in-person visitation and phase three reopening will be distributed to the residents and family members.

We continue our Picnic on the Porch visits with residents and family members. This has continued to be a great opportunity for families and residents to engage together.
