Subject: Path Forward Community Update



Since our communication on Friday, we completed our testing of residents and team members for COVID-19. Today we received test results back and an additional two residents have tested positive for the virus. Those residents and their families have been notified, and everyone is doing well. We did not have any additional team members test positive for the virus.

As a precaution, we are enforcing our current quarantine until October 29. As a reminder, until this day, we will be following the below procedures:

- All residents must quarantine in their apartment and The Legacy will provide all necessary services including meals, mail delivery and virtual programming
- Care and assistance will continue to be provided as normal
- All team members will utilize full PPE including N95 or KN95 masks, goggles, gowns and gloves
- Symptom screening will continue for residents and staff daily
- No in-person visitation will be permitted, this includes families accessing an apartment by way of a first floor patio
- Virtual visits can be scheduled at <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/legacyvirtualvisits>
- End of life visits will be accommodated and approved by myself or Director of Nursing, Lisa Ramsey
- Any deliveries must be left outside the front entrance
- We will regularly disinfect surfaces throughout the community including the kitchen and care bases

I am grateful for the full cooperation of residents, families and The Legacy team over the next couple of weeks. I am confident if we all do our best adhering to the above guidelines, we can slow the spread of the virus throughout the community and start the reopening process again.
