Starting the reopening process means we will start to offer in-person visitation again. However, we are very concerned about the rapid increase of COVID-19 cases throughout the state of Virginia. As we begin to reopen, if you have a visit scheduled with your loved one and are not feeling well, please contact us to reschedule. We can always schedule a virtual visit in lieu of an in-person visit if you are not feeling well. Additional guidelines we ask everyone to follow, recommended by the CDC include:

- First and foremost, always wear a mask when you are around others who do not live in your household
- Avoid large gatherings in crowded and poorly ventilated indoor spaces
- Continue to practice regular hand hygiene, soap and warm water is best, however, if those are not available use hand sanitizer that is at least 60% alcohol based
- When hosting or attending a gathering that includes food, avoid any potluck style meals, limit the number of individuals in the areas where food is being prepared and always wear a mask when preparing food
