Last week we did not have any positive results in team members or in residents. We are hopeful that will be the case again this week, and next week we can begin to ease restrictions again. We will all need to remain extremely vigilant as COVID-19 cases continue to spike across the country, and with an expected increase following the Thanksgiving holiday.

We are starting to hear more on the availability of a vaccination. As you have all heard in the news, there seems to be three vaccines that are viable options. We are working with CVS to secure a vaccination clinic for The Legacy residents and team members. While this will not be mandatory, we do highly recommend it. The Centers for Disease Control is still evaluating who gets the vaccine and when. We know frontline team members will be in the first group; however, we expect the distribution process will focus on long-term care facilities before expanding to Assisted Living.
