Last week in our weekly testing, one team member tested positive for COVID-19. This positive test result means that we cannot make any operational changes at The Legacy. As a reminder, we must have two weeks without any positive test results in either team members or residents to begin easing restrictions.

I am pleased that although team members have tested positive, residents continue to remain healthy. My team is committed to wearing personal protective equipment correctly and doing everything we know that works to keep residents protected from the virus.

We are excited that vaccinations are starting to be approved and delivered to those that need it most. It is unclear when The Legacy will receive ours. The priority is long-term care facilities and hospitals, but I know our community will also be a priority on the list. We will be working with our partners at National Lutheran Communities & Services and CVS, who was chosen to distribute vaccines as a part of Operation Warp Speed. We will provide more information as we have it available.

With Christmas coming next week, we have received questions about gifts for residents. We are happy to accept gifts for your loved one. Please drop them off at the front entrance. We will ensure they are delivered.
