Subject: Path Forward Community Update



I hope each of you have found a renewed sense of hope this first week of 2021. I am certainly hopeful for a brighter 2021.

Our testing last week did not identify any new cases of COVID-19 at The Legacy. As the country continues to see a post-holiday surge in case numbers, we have made the decision to remain extremely cautious and continue to limit visitation to virtual visits and screen porch visits. As a reminder, we are not allowing family members to enter the building by using a first floor patio entrance.

We are preparing for our first vaccination clinic this Friday, January 8. Our clinic is in partnership with CVS, who was chosen by the federal government as a part of Operation Warp Speed. We are collecting consent forms from residents and team members. If your loved one cannot make their own medical decisions, our team will contact the medical Power of Attorney to complete a consent or declination form.

I know one of the questions many will have as we roll out the vaccine is “when can we return to normal?” As an assisted living community, we are regulated by the state and federal governments.
