Subject: Path Forward Community Update



In our testing last week, we did not identify any new cases of COVID-19 in our community. If we can reach two weeks without any positive test results, we can consider easing restrictions to allow for small gatherings. We will also evaluate if and when we can safely reopen in-person visitation.

We hold our second vaccine clinic on Friday. I believe we will have 100% participation by residents, which will certainly be a step in the right direction. The CDC has updated their vaccination website with guidance on what to expect with restrictions following the vaccine. Importantly, they are directing that even after receiving the second dose, we should continue to wear masks, comply with social distancing and continue to regularly disinfect hands and high-touched surfaces. Specifically, the CDC states “Experts need to understand more about the protection that COVID-19 vaccines provide in real-world conditions before making that decision.
