Pinecone Owls or Turkeys

Materials:

- Pinecones
- Googly eyes
- Felt or colored paper (for wings, beaks, feathers)
- Glue or glue gun

Directions:

1. Glue googly eyes onto felt.
2. Cut out wings, beak, or feathers from felt or paper.
3. Glue pieces onto the pinecone to create an owl or turkey.
4. Let dry before handling.



Pumpkin Patch Dirt Cups

Ingredients:

- Chocolate pudding cups (or homemade pudding)
- Crushed chocolate sandwich cookies
- Gummy worms
- Candy pumpkins

Directions:

1. Fill a cup halfway with pudding.
2. Add a layer of crushed cookies.
3. Tuck in gummy worms so they “crawl” out.
4. Place candy pumpkins on top to make a “patch.”
